



The Bible Everywhere Challenge

As we come to the end of another year, it's time to start thinking about the goals we'll set for the new one. To help with that, I want to ask a few questions. All I ask is that you answer honestly. Don't overthink it—just be genuine.



finding out the gender of your baby, do we immediately post about it online?

We've handed so much of our attention and energy to our phones that they've consumed our lives. No one even notices when someone walks around glued to a screen anymore. That's why I want to challenge you as we step into a new year.

Here's the challenge:

Take your Bible everywhere.

It sounds simple, right? You might already have a Bible app on your phone, and that's great! But no one will think twice when they see you looking at your phone—it looks

like what everyone else is doing. I'm asking you to carry a physicalBible with you wherever you go.

Now, open your Bible to three passages: **Psalm 119:11**, **Joshua 1:8**, and **Matthew 4:4**. Take a moment to read them. When you finish, let's unpack what they teach us.

1. Treasure the Word of God in your heart.

Psalm 119:11 reminds us to store up God's Word in our hearts. If we truly treasure Scripture, shouldn't it be the first thing we turn to in the morning? And before bed, shouldn't we dwell on it so our souls find spiritual rest before our bodies find physical rest?

Imagine calling your boss and saying, "I'll be late—I left my Bible at home and had to go back for it." That's what it means to treasure God's Word: making it such an essential part of your life that you can't go anywhere without it.

Take it to work or school. Bring it to the grocery store. Have it with you at the movie theater. Let Scripture become so treasured in your heart

Are you ready? Here we go:

- What's the first thing you check when you wake up?
- What's the last thing you look at before you go to sleep?
- When something bad happens, what's the first thing you turn to?
- When something great happens, what's the first thing you turn to?
- On your way to work, what would make you turn around and risk being late to go back home for?

Hopefully, you see where I'm going with this.

How often do we start and end our days with our phones—scrolling mindlessly through reels or posts? When something upsets us, do we rush to share it on Facebook? When something amazing happens, like

that you can't imagine life without it.

2. Meditate on it day and night.

If you're going to carry it everywhere, you might as well read it. Sitting in the lobby waiting for an oil change? Read your Bible. Taking a break in your car? Read your Bible. Wondering what's most important for the day when you wake up? Read your Bible. Trouble falling asleep? Read your Bible.

No matter what you face, remember that everything you need comes from Scripture. God gave us His Word for a reason! We can't neglect it just because we're busy. Reading and studying Scripture must be a daily practice.

3. Let the Word sustain you.

The Bible isn't something to turn to only when life gets hard—it's what sustains us every day. Think about grocery shopping. You make a list of what you need to get through the next week or two. Without those items, you and your family would go hungry.

Our souls hunger too. We can't neglect what God made them to need. The Bible is a well of knowledge and truth that never runs dry—a source of living water that satisfies our deepest thirst. Through His Word, God speaks truth and shows us what it means to follow Him.

So, as we enter this next year, I want to invite you to a new kind of challenge. I'm not asking you to read the Bible in a year—though that's a wonderful goal. This challenge will stretch you in different ways. It'll make you rethink your daily routines. You might get some curious looks. You might even be asked why you're doing it.

But as time goes on, you'll find the "weight" of carrying your Bible becomes lighter. You'll notice God working in your heart. And who knows? Maybe He'll use it to open a door for you to share the Gospel with someone along the way.

Will you join me in The Bible Everywhere Challenge?

If you do, pray for strength to finish strong. Pray for others taking the challenge. And pray that God uses this to draw you—and those around you—closer to Him.

I love you all and pray that God blesses you through the end of this year and into the next!
