Annie Armstrong Easter Offering

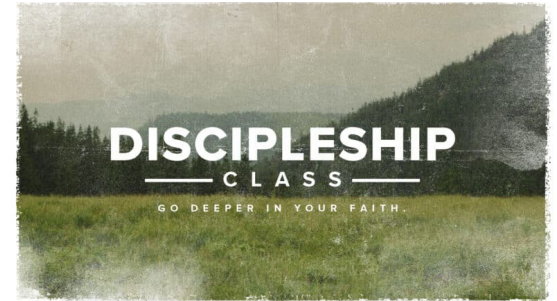
